Reflections on the last National Tour Event in Wilmington, Ohio

I was very pleased with my performance this year finishing second in ES at the last National Tour event in Wilmington, Ohio. Here is the scoop on how the event compares to our local events, and if you are considering growing your game next year, make sure you get your practice in at KYSCCA Events so we can grow our Region's attendance at SCCA National Tour Events.

The Site – Upon first arriving at a National Tour Event the first thing one will notice is the scale of the event itself. It is a local event on steroids! With 300+ people in attendance everything needs to be done efficiently and with purpose. Paddock is large and organized, tech has its own trailer and equipment, and registration is conducted out of a separate trailer with separate lines. While the scale can be

intimidating, the basic features are the same.

The Cars – The best part of the event is the view walking through paddock. While they still allow boring ES Toyota MR Spyders to compete, there are also some very nice purpose built vehicles. Most cars are prepped to the limit of their class, which makes for some interesting setups, especially in the modified and prepared categories.

The Course – National Tour Events are held on some of the best sites in the country. They are typically conducted on large concrete air pads, meaning that course designers have a lot of room to work with. Also, being on concrete, there is an increased level of grip not found on asphalt courses. This typically leads to higher speeds than we are accustomed to locally.

Regional Executive Jamey McDaniel called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

The following were present: Jamey McDaniel, Brian Mason, Dave Melton, Bruce Domeck, Rich Sinnock, Nathan Steinke, Shawn Lambert, Tony Morrow and Winn Willinger.

Jamey McDaniel presented the May 2014 minutes to review. The minutes were accepted.

Financial Report: Treasurer Rich Sinnock reported on club financials.

- Around \$11,500 in operating account after all the bills have been paid.
- Only outstanding bills are the port-a-pots for the year, weekend membership fees for the year, and UPS lot fees.
- Financial Report motioned to accept. Passed by board members.

Old Business: No old business to discuss.

New Business:

• **Points Event 6**

- J. McDaniel will be event chair.
- Event is being moved to UPS.
- Karl Miller will be designing the course.
- Dave Melton has agreed to tow trailer to and from the event.
- Jamey McDaniel needs assistance roping off the lot Saturday. Nathan Steinke volunteered.
- TARC has been contacted. Port-a-pots should be on site day of the event.

• **Winn Willinger**

- Winn Willinger from REV Advantage, LLC attended the board meeting to discuss for the Louisville Downs racetrack
- He is working on a grass roots movement to bring motorsports events to Louisville and the main focus is Louisville Downs. (currently there are talks to have flat track motorcycle races next year.)
- Mr. Willinger is also trying to convince the Louisville Police Foundation to use their to pave the parking lot of Louisville Downs and use it as their training pad facility. The lot could then have the potential of providing a new autocross event site.
- Mr. Willinger's reason for visiting the meeting was to inform us of his plans and to drum up interest in having more motorsports events at Louisville Downs.
- If Mr. Willinger's plan is a success and KYSCCA does decide to host an event at Louisville Downs, all agreements and rental fees would be going to Churchill Downs.

• **Fire Extinguisher Recharge**

- All extinguishers were checked. Two were replaced due to needing recharged. All Extinguishers inspections are good until August 2014.
- We will check them all again in Spring 2015.

• **Street Survival, Saturday night & Sunday Autocross.**

- We need to find a tractor-trailer for the Street Survival School.
- Need to workout the details of classroom and lunch location.
- Planning for Saturday and Sunday autocrosses is going well.
- Need 10 coaches. Anyone who completes on-line test can coach.

• **Banquet menu, location, prelim outline and such**

- Overview: January 25, J-Town Community Center, 200 guests.
- Masterson's Catering: Total cost for 200 guests: \$3068.70.
- Room for 200 people at J-Town Community Center: \$650.00
- Ticket sales will be \$20 for a single ticket, \$15 for a guest and \$5 per kid (12 years and under), limited to 5 kids.
- Tabled discussion for next board meeting:
 - Move event from Sunday Jan. 25 to Saturday, Jan. 24.
 - Nail down variable cost per person.
- Jamey would like to book the J-Town Community Center if January 24th is open.
- The board agreed to hold the January 2015 board meeting on Jan. 28th instead of before the banquet. location to be determined.

• **Corvette Motorsports Park Site Location**

- Andrew Jennings of the Tennessee Region contacted Jamey McDaniel and requested KYSCCA to contact the SCCA and allow the Tennessee Region to use the skid pad at the Corvette Motorsports Park.
- Jamey has contacted the SCCA National Office and given permission for only the skid pad on TR's designated dates. Any other events or dates will need KYSCCA approval.

- Dave Melton brought up the idea of an alternative meeting location when Bruce's garage is not available.
- Trailer access is problematic Dave would like to explore other locations with better security and access for the trailer.
- **Rallycross**
 - Dave and Nathan met with KEC to look at the lots for rallycross.
 - SCCA National Office is waiving the sanction fees for our clubs first 2 events and insurance is only \$3.50 per car.

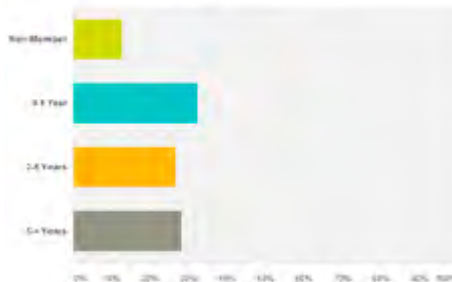

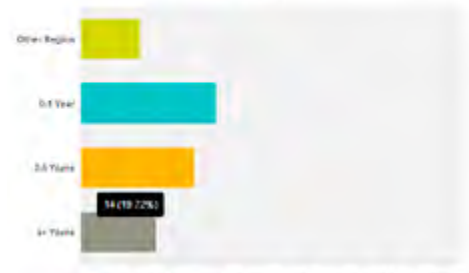

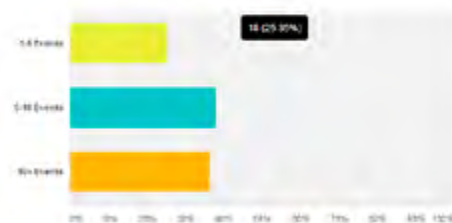
How long have you been an SCCA Member?



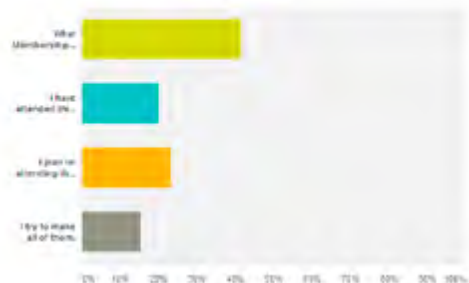
How long have you been a Kentucky Region Member?
