Annual Tech Day.....

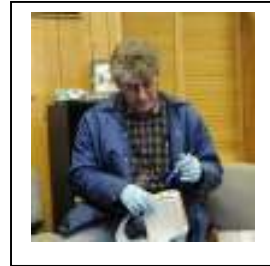
Despite a cold day with intermittent showers, a number of Kentucky Region members braved the weather to take advantage of our annual tech

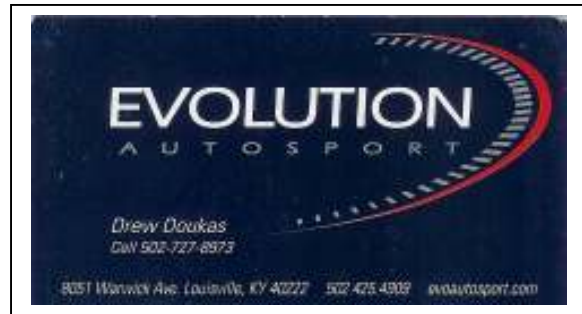
