

SCCA 2009 Fee Structure

TOPEKA, Kan. (Dec. 9, 2009) – The SCCA® Board of Directors finalized its 2009 fee structure for dues, sanctions and insurance. While some areas of the business will experience inflation, others will enjoy decreases.

"Overall, the news is positive for active participants in SCCA," SCCA President and CEO Jim Julow said. "While there are some increases in our fees, we have also found considerable savings on the insurance side that offset these. The cost of running any business continues to rise, but we've been able to find some relief for 2009, which is passed through directly to Regions and our participants.

"Overall, the cost to Regions of running an event will not increase from 2008 to 2009."

Membership dues will increase \$5 from \$60 to \$65. Family dues will increase \$6 to \$101, while spouse memberships will increase \$3 to \$23. This is the first dues increase in three years. First Gear memberships remain unchanged.

Fee increases were offset by a reduction in insurance fees across the board. For the first time in several years, the Club-wide insurance policy was put out to bid, with responses coming from four different carriers.

Additional changes included:

Club Racing

- Increase Regional and National competition licenses by \$5
- Elimination of distinction between spectator and non-spectator at a flat rate of \$1,400 for liability insurance
- Decrease Club Racing PA Insurance \$5 per car to \$28
- Decrease Driver School PA Insurance \$3 per car to \$19
- Decrease Time Trials/Hillclimb PA Insurance \$3 and \$4 per car, respectively

Rally

- Increase RallyCross Sanction Fee from \$3 to \$3.50 per car
- Increase Road Rally Sanction Fee for Regional events from \$2 to \$4 per car
- Sanction fee for a 3-day or longer event changed to \$500 per event
- Increase sanction fee for a charity event \$20 to \$70
- Decrease RallyCross Insurance fee \$1 per car to \$4

Solo

- Increase Regional Solo Sanction Fee from \$3.75 to \$4.50 per car
- Decrease Insurance \$1 per car to \$5

With the changes, the Solo Department has made a policy change requiring event audits to take place within two weeks from the end of the event.

Volunteer Incentive Programs remained unchanged from 2008.

A full list of changes will be listed in the January 2009 Fastrack® news. Additional information about the implementation process and timeline will be communicated at a later date.





competitive one.




Bucket O'Bolts Award......

2009 Kentucky Region Drivers' School

The Kentucky Region Drivers' School will be held Saturday, **May 23rd** and is easily the best bang for the buck that our region has to offer in terms of seat time, instruction, and experience. This year's school will be held at Papa Johns Cardinal Stadium on the Saturday prior to our regular May 24th Points Event #4. The cost for the school is \$75 for KYR Members and Associate Members. Currently registration is open to SCCA members only. Please note that this fee **includes your entry fee for the following day's points event**. It also includes your lunch for the day on Saturday and will net you dozens of runs - solo, with instructors riding, and with instructors driving. Basically you can cram a season's worth of seat time into one day, focusing on some of the key elements that are common to a majority of autocross courses.

Please make note of the following important registration information: There will be **no online or walk-up registration for the drivers' school.** In order to register you **must mail a check made out to KYSCCA to the address listed below to reserve your spot.** Registration for this school will be capped at 40 drivers in order to keep the student to instructor ratio ideal. A running tally of those who have been registered is being updated on the KYR website.

PLEASE Include some contact information on the check or along with it so that we can get in touch with you in the event of any unforeseen problems or changes.

Once registered, you'll need to show up the morning of the school at Papa Johns (directions available at kyscca.com) no later than 8am. There will be a brief meeting with the instructors and event chair to break the students down into groups - one more oriented towards beginners and one for those who have more than a season's worth of experience. Once we go over the format for the day, we will split up and each group will work with its instructors one-on-one for the majority of the morning. After lunch, the format will become more loose and the students will make more solo runs and may have the opportunity to run on the other groups' course.

All students are to provide their own vehicles for the school in ready-to-run trim. No co-driven cars will be allowed.

We will be able to perform a tech inspection on cars of those who have not run with us in the past. Loaner helmets will be available, but students are encouraged to bring their own if they have one.

I will update this posting to list the instructors for the school in the coming weeks. I can assure you that they'll be familiar names and those that you'll often see at the top of our indexed results. This region has a wealth of experienced and fast drivers that are also skilled, patient teachers this event is our opportunity to help each other improve, have fun, and get faster.

I hope to see many of you there!





As some may already be aware, there have been a few noise complaints from Wilder Park. In an effort to diffuse the issue before we get removed from the lot there will be a change or two coming for the last 3 events.

First, course design will dictate a slower section along the tracks in an effort to cut the noise directly next to the homes.

The previous sound threshold was 96db @ 100'. We are going to cut this to 92db. In an effort to set the bar, the CM group is all having to buy mufflers to meet these new sound requirements. We are going to be stringent with this requirement so if there is any concern you may not be able to meet the new levels please adjust your car before hand.

Finally.... Wilder Park is requesting that we move the PJCS events to Saturday. This change is dependent on PJs and we have not yet heard back if this is possible. 


