2014 is winding down and for many of us the attention is turned from our cars to the holiday season allowing for a nice, relaxing break scene. As KYSCCA leadership plans the 2015 season we have noticed it will be hard to top 2014. We hosted several new event formats, AutoXed at new venue and even got our feet wet with Track Racing. Here are the **2014 Season Highlights**:

- After a rough start where we decided to cancel our first event due to freezing rain we were able to get back on track and we hosted the Evolution Performance Phase 1 Driving School which sold out for the second year in a row.
- That same day we held a Solo Safety Steward class where 20 potential new safety stewards attended, many of which went on to acquire their license.
- KYSCCA made some new friends this year. Sam Swope Fiat & Mini of Louisville gave free entries at all of our events this year to SCCA Members and supplied snacks and drinks.
- In April and October several KYSCCA members helped with the TRSS (Tire Rack Street Survival Teen Driving School) at NCM (National Corvette Museum.)
- For additional education and fun we added a TNT (test-n-tune) to the region driver's school. Both were huge successes with our world famous driver's school continuing 1:1 instructor/student ratio and the TNT included unlimited runs with no worker rotation thanks to The Winning Formula and the UofL fSAE team.
- Derby weekend the club hosted the Midwest Muscle Car Challenge where 60 of the finest Muscle and Pro-Touring cars from the eastern half of the country duked it out in multiple racing fashions and many participants AutoXed for the very first time!
- We even found time to represent KYSCCA in the Kroger/NASCAR Fan Fest promotional tour all over Greater Louisville all summer.

NCM's Grand Opening also has volunteers from KYSCCA, we have been all over the place!!!

Immediately following the NCM Motorsports Park Grand Opening the club dove head first into the 24 Hours of LeCone, a weekend jam packed with autocross fun:

It began by the club hosting our very first TRSS. A huge success selling out all 30 spots and having another 14 on the wait list. There will likely be two Louisville TRSS in 2015.

Later that evening the club hosted its very first night AutoX, after a delayed start due to lightning in the area we had more than 80 cars turn out and we AutoXed into the darkness at KFEC!

The following morning we drew out a new course and went back at it again for another Points Event AutoX!

Holley LS Fest was a huge success and we were privileged to host the AutoX and Speed Stop for our second time Bowling Green, Kentucky. This event continues to grow thanks to our dedicated club volunteers who tirelessly work to put on what has become the premier Muscle Car/Pro-Touring competition in the country. 125 competitors competed over 3 days!

2014 is officially the year of multitasking. The Inaugural NCM AutoX is yet another example of KYSCCA Going BIG!

We hosted one of the largest Starting Line Schools to date on the NCMMP autocross pad.

At the same time on the other end of the massive AutoX pad the region held its second TNT of the year.

The following day we hosted not only our largest AutoXi n years but also the largest Great Lakes Solo Series event of the year on the NCM AutoX pad with close to 200 entries from as far away at Michigan and Georgia.

Closing out the season 30 of our members worked a Starting Line School Track day at NCM where they not only learned corner working but also had a taste of the NCM Track and fun so big we are still talking about it and reliving the exciting moments. 2014 Monthly Membership Meetings were held at BIK (Bluegrass Indoor Karting) with more attendance on average per meeting that 2013's total attendees for the entire year.

Proof of the growing excitement in the region due to amazing teamwork, successful autox events and additional enthusiast events; membership grew from approximately 180 members at the beginning of the season to 280 members at the end.



The Inaugural NCM Autocross Weekend. Brian Mason KYSCCA Activities Director.

The weekend started Saturday with a SCCA Starting Line School where more than twenty students were taught the basics of AutoXing and car handling. The morning session started with the coaches running everyone through a simple but incredibly effective skid oval/figure eight as well as a long slalom. Then for the afternoon, a course was set where the students took twenty plus runs with instruction, on their own and with seasoned volunteers. The students were even taught how to work a course which as we all know is very valuable!

The opposite end of the massive pad the held a test-n-tune course where it was a first come first served event, purchasing 3 runs for \$10 with no limit as long as there was time and workers. Early Registration/Tech opened for Sunday's Divisional AutoX allowing competitors to show up early, get their paddock spot, check in, walk the course and sleep a little later Sunday morning.

Bright and early Sunday we were greeted with a heavy layer of fog which made finding your paddock spot a challenge! Registration/Tech continued without delay thanks to our region's large group of early worker position volunteers, most also worked the T&T the day before. The fog limited course visibility so much that it delayed the event start by 45 minutes. Once under way the 190+ competitors ran 4 runs on the fast and fun Shawn Lambert and crew designed course, with the exception of a little motor (and subsequent course) oiling problem, the event ran smoothly and continuously with the heat worker changeovers switching on the fly.

NCM is large enough to host multiple events simultaneously. The Mid -West Cafe Motorcycle Group hosted races on the track while we burned rubber on the pad. This gave competitors their choice to watch some AutoX on their off heats and or wander over and check out some two-wheel racing action. Many motorcycle spectators saw AutoX for what may have been the very first time and we think they liked what they saw and hope it gained new interest in the sport! The event was a big hit to say the least. With competitors traveling as far away as Michigan, Alabama and Georgia, and a huge turnout from KYSCCA largely based in Louisville. A big thanks to the Great Lakes Solo Series for supplying trophies and some giveaways! Can't wait to go back!
