The Feb. minutes were read by Andrew Scott. A correction needed to be made in the minutes regarding the motion made concerning the club taxes. Motion to accept minutes as amended by Erik Mohn and seconded by Phil Wells. Motion carried.

A financial report was provided by Treasurer Paul Ward. Phil Wells made a motion to accept the financial report as read. It was seconded by Chris Granger and the motion passed. Phil Wells also presented the Treasurer with a check from BlueGrass Motorsports--Porsche for sponsorship of the 2007 Solo Challenge Series.

Old Business:

New Business: There was a discussion about the upcoming Test & Tune and the

Price was set at \$40/members and \$45/temporary members (non-members). James Duncan seconded the motion and the motion carried

Motion carried. Erik Mohn has volunteered to handle MyAutoEvents administration for the region in 2007.

Cindy Duncan and Adam Blake will share Chief of Timing duties for 2007.

Bruce Domeck moved to adjourn, seconded by Phil Wells. Motion carried.
