

What a month! It Started out in Lincoln, NE with a handful of KYSCCA members and a group of members from our sister club, CKRSCCA. From there it was down to Bowling Green where our club once again hosted an autocross for Holly's LS Fest, this time at NCM. Two Points events, one in Louisville and the other in Bowling Green.. then back to Bowling Green for the first ever SCCA Time Trials Nationals!

Solo Gnats (not a typo, possibly a plague?) was long days and lots of rain. Still, Eric Brown and Ray Dsouza both managed to bring home trophies. The rest of us, well, we are still drying off. Trying to deliver three runs each to about 700 drivers in the rain slows things down a bit. The event eventually was shut down near the end of the last heat as the sun had set and there were no area lights.. so dark is DARK! To give you a scale we generally cap out around 700 timed runs in a day. They did 2100, but that was split between two courses bring run simultaneously. Let's hope next year's weather makes up for the terrible weather we had this year.

Solo Points event 6 was at KFEC. Some leftover cars form the prior days tailgating meant we had to adjust our usual footprint on the fly. The event was trouble free and upped to 7 runs as we made it through the early runs so quickly.

Solo Points event 7 took place in Bowling Green at the NCM pad. The weather was threatening and certainly made for a soggy morning. The rain ended around 11:00 am, the short turnout meant that all drivers got 7 runs and we were done by noon. It just goes to show how unpredictable our weather can be. Thanks to those who committed to running this event rain or shine. I'm sure it had an impact on year end points for a few classes.

The first ever Time Trials Nationals is in the books. They have announced a 10 year contract to host this event at NCM on the last weekend of September. If you missed this one

you have plenty of time to get ready for the next one. This is open to nearly all production based cars and if you aren't quite ready to put your car on a track, there are many worker positions where they train you on site. Our region was well represented both in participation and podiums. The National office also announced a Time Trials Tour for 2019, look for additional details as they develop.
